- **Chocoa Chocolate Festival** (February 8-9): A weekend celebration where around 8,000 chocolate enthusiasts will gather at Beurs van Berlage. The festival will feature tastings, entertainment and booths from global exhibitors, offering consumers a chance to explore and purchase diverse cocoa products.
